

## **Scotland's Path – Terms and conditions**

Thank you for considering a donation as part of the Scotland's Path product by Scotland's Charity Air Ambulance (SCAA), a registered charity in Scotland (Charity No. SC041845). By submitting a name and making a qualifying donation, you accept the terms outlined below.

### **Scotland's Path product**

- Scotland's Path is a fundraising product that allows supporters who donate the minimum amount outlined below to have their loved one's name, displayed on a memorial path installed at both our Perth base (Perth Airport, Scone, PH2 6PL) and Aberdeen base (Hangar 2B, Farburn Terrace, Aberdeen, AB21 7DT).
- This product is a standalone initiative and begins on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Any donations made before this date, or not explicitly intended for Scotland's Path, are not eligible.
- SCAA reserves the right to update, suspend, or cancel the product, or amend these Terms and Conditions, at any time. Changes will be communicated on the SCAA website.

### **Name submission guidelines**

- Supporters must be 16 or over to submit a name.
- Each £100 donation allows for the inclusion of one name.
- Supporters may submit multiple names (one per minimum donation amount as detailed above).
- For each donation, supporters will receive a personalised certificate and commemorative pin badge dispatched to the billing address provided during donation.

### **Name Display Conditions**

- Names will be displayed on a memorial path at both the SCAA Perth and Aberdeen base as detailed above.
- All names will be printed in a uniform font and size.
- Each name:
  - Must include one individual (e.g. "John Smith") for individual donations or one group name ("e.g. Glasgow Volunteer Group")
  - Must be no more than 30 characters, including titles, spaces, and punctuation.
  - May include Formal titles (e.g., Dr., Mr., Lady, Captain)
  - Must not include business names, emojis, special characters (other than hyphens),
  - Must not include offensive/discriminatory content.

- SCAA may request an alternative if a submitted name is unsuitable for display.
- Supporters are responsible for submitting accurate name details. If you identify an error, email [enquiries@scaa.org.uk](mailto:enquiries@scaa.org.uk) as soon as possible. SCAA cannot guarantee changes can be made after submission, but will make every attempt to accommodate corrections where feasible.

### **Decal details**

- Each path will contain approximately 1000 names. Submitted names will be displayed at both our Perth and Aberdeen bases.
- Supporters cannot choose where on the design their chosen name appears.
- The final design and layout of the Decal is at the discretion of SCAA.
- Images of the memorial path are provided for illustrative purposes only and have been created with the use of artificial intelligence (AI). Illustrative mock ups are non-contractual and subject to change.

### **Product close and capacity**

- The product will remain open until all name spaces are filled or SCAA determines to close the product.
- Any names submitted after capacity has been reached will be contacted. Supporters may choose a refund or to reassign their donation to general funds.
- To ensure we use charitable funds responsibly and manage the allocated budget effectively, the memorial path may be installed in phases depending on the number of dedications received. Supporters will be kept informed on installation progress via email updates.
- Names will remain on the path for a minimum of 10 years.

### **Recognition & Ownership**

- Submission of a name does not confer any ownership rights to the path.
- No entitlement to access the aircraft or SCAA facilities is granted through participation.
- Future opportunities to view the path in person may arise via public events; attendance is not guaranteed and is subject to availability.

### **Timings and Delivery**

- Product closure, installation of names, and delivery of commemorative materials are subject to reasonable delays.
- SCAA is not liable for delays outside of its control.
